

## Graduation Requirements Newark College of Arts and Sciences University College-Newark

### Students must:

- Complete a minimum of 120 degree credits
- Complete the Core Curriculum
- Declare and complete a major program of study
  - Minimum of half of the degree credits for a major must be completed at RU-N
- Declare and complete a Second Concentration
  - Minimum of half of the degree credits for a the second concentration must be completed at RU-N
- Complete two Writing Intensive Courses with minimum grade of “C”
- Successfully earn a minimum grade of “C” in all major and second concentration courses
- Successfully obtain a minimum cumulative grade-point average of a 2.0 or better. (Major departments may require a higher GPA).

### The Core Curriculum:

All students are required to complete the Core Curriculum. The Core Curriculum is designed to ensure that all graduates acquire a broad range of knowledge, skills, and competencies across the arts and sciences. The seven general education categories are listed to the right.

<u>Basic Writing Skills</u> (minimum grade “C”)	6 credits
<u>Quantitative Reasoning</u> (minimum grade “C”)	3 credits
<u>Natural Sciences</u>	8 credits
<u>Social Sciences</u>	6 credits
<u>History &amp; Literature</u>	9 credits
<u>Arts &amp; Media</u>	3 credits
<u>Other Liberal Arts</u>	3 credits
<b>Total:</b>	<b>38 credits</b>
