Degree Requirements

Thirty-five (35) credits are required for the degree of Master of Science in Global Affairs, all of which must be completed as coursework.

- One (1) Foundation Course: *Evolution of the Global System* [**3 credits**]
- One (1) Colloquia Series with grades of Pass [**2 credits**]
- One (1) Research and Methodology courses [**3 credits**]
- Three (3) Course Electives [**9 credits**]
- Language Requirement [**no credit**]

COURSE REQUIREMENTS

- **Areas of Inquiry** [18 credits]

Students must complete seven (6) of the eight AI courses with grades of B (3.0) or higher in each course to remain in the program. Students who do not receive a grade of B or higher in any AI course must retake the course.

All AI requirements must be completed in residence. Transfer credits may not be used in fulfillment of AI requirements.
